

DOL Excellence in Behaviour for Learning PE Kit Staged Consequences

If excused from taking part in PE, students must still bring their kit and get changed if physically <u>able</u> to do so. A phone call/email to reception explaining why non-participation is required will be expected by your PE teacher. Non-participants will take up an <u>alternate role</u> in the lesson, even if that is outside.

Warning

For the first instance you forget your kit in the half term.

Consequence 1

For the second instance you forget your kit in the half term.

You will be issued with a 20 minute detention that same day with your PE teacher.

Consequence 2

Refusal to borrow spare PE kit.

You will be issued with a 40 minute detention that same day.

Consequence 3—Removal

Failure to carry out an alternate role/task in the lesson.

You will be issued with a 60 minute detention the same day and removed to the subject leader for the lesson.

You may also receive a placement in the BSC, depending on the reason for your removal.

PE kit which is expected:

Essential items	Optional items
Blue embroidered polo shirt	Black embroidered or plain black long sleeve top (1/4 zip or hoodie)
Black school embroidered bottoms or Plain black bottoms with no logos (tracksuit bottoms, leggings or shorts)	Rugby/Hockey mouth guard (strongly advised)
Spare trainers (no plimsolls)	Shin pads (strongly advised)
Swimwear, towel and swim cap for long hair	Football boots (strongly advised)
Hair bobble for long hair	Swimming goggles
