## Uniform Expectations

We are making a small amendment to our uniform expectations from September. At present the policy states that skirts should be of an appropriate length and of a non-jersey type material. This is open to interpretation so we are asking that if your child would like to wear a skirt for school from September, it should be a school approved one. There are two skirts available and details are given on the next page. Skirts will be available from school and from the Trutex website. JK Clothing in Jarrow also stock Trutex skirts however you must ensure you purchase one of the school approved skirts from the range they have in stock.

Students will still have the option to wear trousers if they would prefer and the rest of the expectations regarding uniform remain the same.

We appreciate that you may have already purchased uniform for your child to wear in September and do not wish for you to incur any further expense so are happy to cover the cost of one skirt. If you would like one of our school approved skirts to be provided free of charge, please contact the relevant Head of Year and they will make the necessary arrangements to ensure the correct size is given.

We also have a range of sizes of the school approved skirts in stock that students can try on. This will help if you're unsure of which size to purchase. Additional skirts can also be purchased from school at the discounted rate of £10 in the first instance. These will be available in July.
