Academic Intervention Programme

At Jarrow School we are committed to ensuring every student reaches their full potential. As part of this commitment, we are introducing a series of academic intervention sessions designed to provide targeted support in key subjects.

These sessions aim to help students consolidate their understanding, build confidence, and develop the skills needed to achieve success in their GCSEs. For many students, this extra support can make a significant difference in closing small gaps in knowledge and boosting overall progress.

Your child has been identified as someone who would benefit from this additional support because current assessment information places them in the bottom 10% of their class in the selected subject. This does not define your child's ability; rather, it enables us to identify where additional support is needed so that we can respond early and effectively.

Attendance at these sessions is therefore **essential**, and we ask for your full cooperation in ensuring your child takes part. Together, we can make sure they remain on track and have the best possible platform for success. Please note that these sessions are not a sanction but an opportunity—an important part of our continued effort to give every student the best chance to succeed.

Following the intervention programme, we will review each student's progress. If a student remains within the bottom 10% of their class in the subject despite the support provided, we may consider a change of teaching set if we believe this could help improve attainment and support future progress. Any such decision would be made carefully and with the student's best interests at the centre of the process.

The intervention sessions will take place on **Week Beginning 22nd June 2026** and **Week Beginning 29th June**. Each session will begin at **2:40pm** and finish at **3:20pm**. Specific details regarding your child's allocated day, time, and location will be provided in their school planner.
